What we're looking for

The successful candidate will be part of a team ensuring that our runways are clear of snow and ice and ready to accept aircraft. The successful candidate will be required to safely operate a variety of heavy equipment such as snowblower and sweeper, plow truck, front-end loader, forklift, and backhoe. Shift work is an essential requirement, and some manual labour will also be required.

Airport experience would be an asset, but on-the-job training will be provided to familiarize the successful candidate with the airport's specialized systems and regulations.

This position requires a valid Class 5 driver's licence with airbrake endorsement (or better). The successful candidate will need to acquire a security clearance, a restricted radio operator's permit and airside vehicle operator's permit.
